<u>P19/S4051/FUL</u> – Land to the North of No's 1 & 2 Spinney Cottages Waterperry Estate Waterperry OX33 1JZ – Development of site adjacent entrance to Waterperry Estate into two new 3-bedroom semi-detached houses. This scheme is the same as that which was granted planning permission (P16/S1878/FUL) and similar to planning permission P15/S4315/FUL which was granted for the construction of a new detached house of the same volume.
